The editor will be required to:

- Coordinate the call for and submission of papers for each issue of Circa
- Be the liaison between the Editorial Board and the authors
- Copy-edit all articles and final submissions for the journal
- Work with all authors to ensure all images are high resolution and have appropriate copyright clearance
- Write the editorial for each issue
- Work with the designer on the design and layout of the journal
- Organise ISBN and required imprint details
- Coordinate the printing of the journal
- Ensure legal deposits of the journal are made at the National Library Australia
- Meet all budget and deadline requirements
- Communicate regularly with the PHA national committee, including attending at least one meeting (online) per annum.

This position pays a fixed fee of \$5,000 per issue.

Publication schedule:

It is expected that there will be an issue of *Circa* published biennially (every two years). With the next issue published in 2024, containing papers from the PHA Conference in September 2023.

As a guide it is expected that each issue of Circa will contain around ten peer-reviewed journal articles. Prospective applicants should refer to past issues for their reference.
